



Online Provider Disclosure Requirement

Federal program integrity regulations require States to obtain certain disclosures from providers upon enrollment and periodically thereafter.

In Delaware, the 2011 online provider disclosure requirement went “live” on 1/3/2011.

According to the Code of Federal Regulations title 42, part 455, sections 100-106, all providers enrolled with the Delaware Medical Assistance Program (DMAP) must complete a disclosure form. This form must be submitted electronically and is an **annual** CMS requirement.

As a contracted managed care organization with Delaware Health and Social Services, Delaware Physicians Care is required to ensure its contracted providers comply with this CMS requirement. Failure to abide by the provider disclosure requirement could result in claim denials.
